This letter is to inform everyone that over the last 24 hours we had 1 resident and 1 staff member test COVID+. We are continuing to monitor all residents and staff for any further symptoms. We continue to follow our strict Infection Control guidelines for all staff and have a plethora of PPE available for all visitors and staff alike.

We continue to do everything at our disposal to keep your loved ones safe. All policies and procedures are being followed and conducted based on the guidance of the NJ Department of Health and CDC. Our Environmental Services continue to routinely disinfect all high touch surfaces and common areas to help ensure we are at the forefront of ending this outbreak within our facility. The local hospitals are seeing an uptick in COVID throughout the county and we therefore ask all visitors to please follow our guidelines when visiting including proper hand hygiene and appropriate PPE where required. If you do not feel well or suspect you may have been in contact with someone who had COVID or have flu like symptoms we kindly ask that you not visit. If you come down with COVID after a visit, we kindly request that you inform us so that we can take the necessary precautions for your loved one at the facility.

We strongly encourage all staff, residents and families to learn about, and receive, the Bivalent Booster.
